## GENERAL INFORMATION



### 1. FACILITIES AND SERVICES AT OUR CENTRE (CAMPUS OF EL PALO, CITY OF MÁLAGA)

- **Building:** 2.000 m2, in a two-story building.
- **Reception room:** spacious room used for the reception of students, lectures, DELE examinations and other activities.
- **Classrooms:** 18 classrooms (all of them with audiovisual equipments).
- **Virtual classroom:** teacher workstation and 15 student workstations.
- **Tutoring:** two offices.
- **Patios:** there are two enclosed patios.
- **Multicultural classroom:** area intended for extra-academic activities where students can study, relax and socialize with other students.
- **Secretary's office:** administration and information office.
- **Wi-fi network:** free wi-fi access for students enrolled in our school.
- **Cultural Mediation:** programme specializing in interaction among students to help them in their integration process.

### 2. SERVICES CLOSE TO OUR CENTRE

- **Bus stops:** 50 m from our Centre, in Avda. de Juan Sebastián Elcano (routes 11, and N-1).
- **Taxi stop:** right in front of our Centre, in Avda. de la Estación de El Palo.
- **Post office:** 50 m from our Centre, in Avda. de Juan Sebastián Elcano, 178.
- **El Palo beach:** 100 m from our Centre, with restaurant services, some under agreement with the CEE-UMA.

Prices of these activities, when not included in the registration fee, will be notified in advance.

### 4. ACADEMIC METHODOLOGY

- The teaching staff of Centro de Español para Extranjeros de la Universidad de Málaga are all Phd and licenciates, highly qualified for their specific training in the teaching of Spanish as a Foreign Language.
- A wide variety of audiovisual and technological materials are used in the classes.
- The eclectic methodology alternates, according to the situations, approaches to different structural and communicative methods.
- Students will be informed about the text books they should purchase.

- In the rest of courses and programmes, the student can choose to take this insurance, communicating it to the Secretary's office.


### 6. ACCOMMODATION

## 1. 22º COURSE OF TEACHING OF SPANISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE

This course is designed to present the main methodological trends as well as the latest developments regarding this area of education. Contents: explanatory classes, individual or cooperative performance workshops, work sessions carrying out research and presenting data, and presentations of the latest publications on the teaching of Spanish as a second language.

## REGISTRATION PROCEDURE



All registrations are personal and non-transferable. Please read the general registration requirements to enroll in our courses and programmes in sections 1 to 7 of the following conditions:

**1. Age.** Students must be at least 16 to register.

**2. Registration options.** Every registration consists of a place reservation fee and enrolment. The total amount of the registration fee (place reservation and enrolment) must be paid previous to the beginning of the chosen course or programme.

**3. Registration payment.** Two-stage payment:

- Place reservation fee: 20% of the registration fee.
- Enrolment: 80% of the registration fee.

**4. Bank account.** Both, the place reservation fee or the total amount payment, may be paid in cash or by bank transfer, free of charge, to the following account:

**6. **7. Cancellation.** Place reservation fee (20% of the registration fees), will not be reimbursed in any case. In order to be entitled to reimbursement for the enrolment fees (80% of the registration fee), students must communicate in writing the Secretary's Office their intention of cancelling the registration, with the necessary documents justifying the cancellation, at least **20 days prior to the beginning of the corresponding course**. There will be no reimbursement after that date. Any bank commissions or costs generated by the reimbursement of the enrolment fees, will be assumed by the student.

**8. Duplicates.** Each duplicate of a certificate costs 12 Euros.
